

# How to Access Information on the Internet

at the Western Pennsylvania Hospital

If you wish to print from a Library computer, you must first login. Printing from the computers is free.

If you do not wish to print from a Library computer, you may cancel the login prompts and proceed directly to the Desktop icons.

To use the Internet, click on the Internet Explorer icon.

The opening page should be the Richard M. Johnston Health Sciences Library Home Page. <http://home.wpahs.org/wph/library>

From here, you have many options:

On the right side of the screen there are Quick Links to the most popular Library resources. You will find electronic journals, electronic texts, and other electronic resources. You may search OVID and PubMed by clicking the links to these databases.

If you want to do a basic Internet search, try using Google, a web "index" which sniffs out websites very quickly. Go to <http://www.google.com> and type in your keywords. Try one of the Library's classes on searching the Internet. Check the Library classes schedule for more details . . .
