

How to View a Video



West Penn Hospital School of Nursing videos are arranged by course number on the shelving units next to the Reserve texts, in the aisle near the photocopier on the lower level of the Library.

Select video that you wish to view.

Take video to the Patient and Family Education Center on the upper level of the Library.

There you will find two videocassette players. One is attached to the wall and is ideal for group viewing. The other is located in the study carrel furthest from the entrance to the room. This has headphones attached and is recommended for use if you are alone and would prefer privacy. Also, if others are using the room for other purposes, you may want to consider using the headphones to keep noise at a minimum.

When you have finished viewing the video, please rewind it and place it back on the shelf in the section where it belongs.

What if?

I do not have time to watch the video here in the Library and want to take it home?

Videos are on Reserve for the entire student body and may not leave the Library unless you have written permission from the instructor. Please be considerate of your fellow classmates and remember that they are required to view the videos in the time allotted also.
