

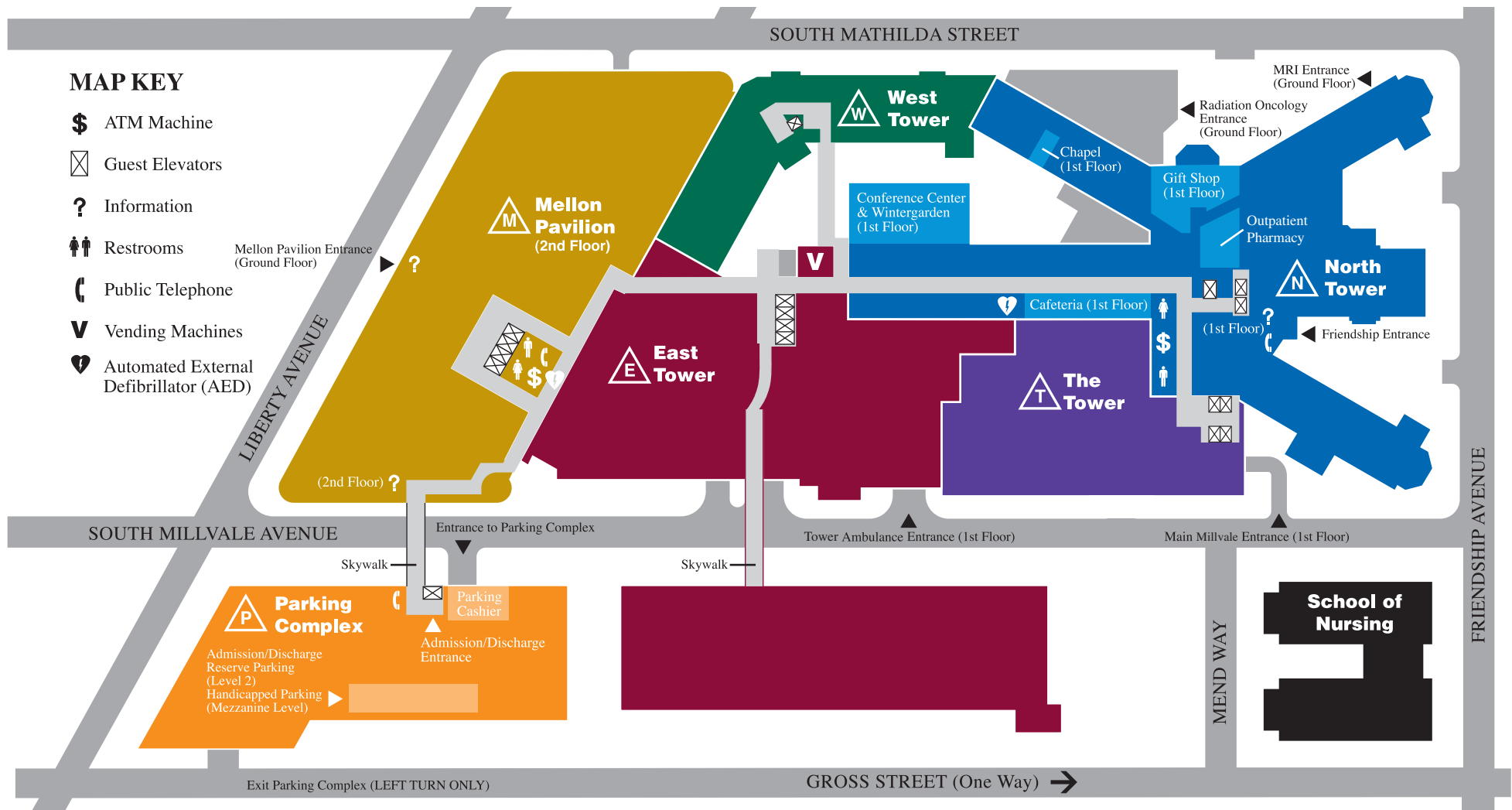

HOW TO USE THIS GUIDE

West Penn Hospital has five color-coded buildings.

Directional arrows (in the carpeting) and overhead signage are located on the **second floor** of each building to assist you in reaching your destination.

Each building can be accessed via the second floor.

1. Locate your destination from Outpatient Service/Department listing (see reverse side).
2. Note the floor and building designation next to the listing.
3. Note your location in relation to the appropriate elevator.
4. Proceed to the proper elevator, take elevator to 2nd floor and follow the color-coded directional arrows (in the carpeting) and overhead signage to your destination.
5. If further information is required, pick up the nearest hospital courtesy phone located throughout the facility and dial extension 5067.

BUILDING COLOR KEY

- Follow gold M arrows to **Mellon Pavilion**
- Follow burgundy E arrows to **East Tower**
- Follow blue N arrows to **North Tower**
- Follow green W arrows to **West Tower**
- Follow purple T arrows to **Tower**
- Follow orange P arrows to **Parking**
